## **Questions**

Of the 6 Uncommon examples of faith Dan spoke of, which are easiest for you? Which are more difficult? (Family perspective, Faith, Commitment to God's plan, Dependence on God's provision, Forgiveness, and Wisdom)

Do you think of your church as family or something else you belong to? Why can it be hard to see the church as family?

In difficult times what is the impact on Faith, Commitment to God's plan, or Dependence on God's provision for you?

Have you ever experienced Uncommon Forgiveness? How did it change you? How about Uncommon Wisdom?

## **Apply SOAP (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer) to:**

Hebrews 11:37-39 (NASB)

They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were tempted, they were put to death with the sword; they went about in sheepskins, in goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented (people of whom the world was not worthy), wandering deserts, on mountains, and sheltering in caves and holes in the ground. And all these, having gained approval through their faith, did not receive what was promised,
