Why do you think we sometimes struggle with Jesus as Lord, but not as Savior?

In the parable of the two builders (Luke 6:48-49), what were some of your take aways from this? How does it help you better understand the question Jesus asks; "Why do you call me Lord, Lord!' when you don't do what I say?"

What does building your life on a firm foundation look like to you? Are their areas in your life that you feel might be built on sand instead of rock?

Scripture Discovery:

Have yourself, another group member, or all group members read the following Scripture out loud

1 Peter 3:15 (NLT)

Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it.

What does this passage tell us about God?
