Questions

Why do you think God gives us the chance to obey his Word or guidance instead of forcing us to do his will?

The Israelites were afraid when they found themselves between Pharaoh's army and the Red Sea, despite being firsthand witnesses to God's many miracles. What does this tell us about the power of Fear over Faith? What are some practical things we can do to help ourselves in these situations?

Why do Faith and Obedience walk hand in hand in our lives?

Apply SOAP (Scripture, Observation, Application, Prayer) to:

Galatians 6:7-10 (NIV)

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Let us not become weary in doing good for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.
